e.g. 农历九月初九是中国的重 阳节,人们登高远眺、观赏菊 花、吃重阳糕、饮菊花酒。The ninth day of the ninth lunar month is the Double Ninth Festival in China. People climb high and appreciate chrysanthemums, eat Chongyang cakes, and drink chrysanthemum wine.

2. 春天 chūntiān - spring

e.g. 春天来了, 温暖的阳光照 耀着大地。Spring is here, and the warm sun shines on the earth.

3. 踏青 tàqīng - outing

e.g. 现在是初春,正是踏青的 好季节。Now is early spring, and it's a good season for outings.
