e.g. 中秋月圆人团圆。The moon is round and people are reunited at the Mid-Autumn Festival.

2. 灯节 dēngjié - lantern festival

e.g. 中秋是中国三大灯节之一。Mid-Autumn Festival is one of the three major lantern festivals in China.

3. 桂花 guīhuā - sweet osmanthus

e.g. 人们经常在中秋时吃月饼、赏桂花。People often eat moon cakes and enjoy sweet-scented osmanthus during the Mid-Autumn Festival.
